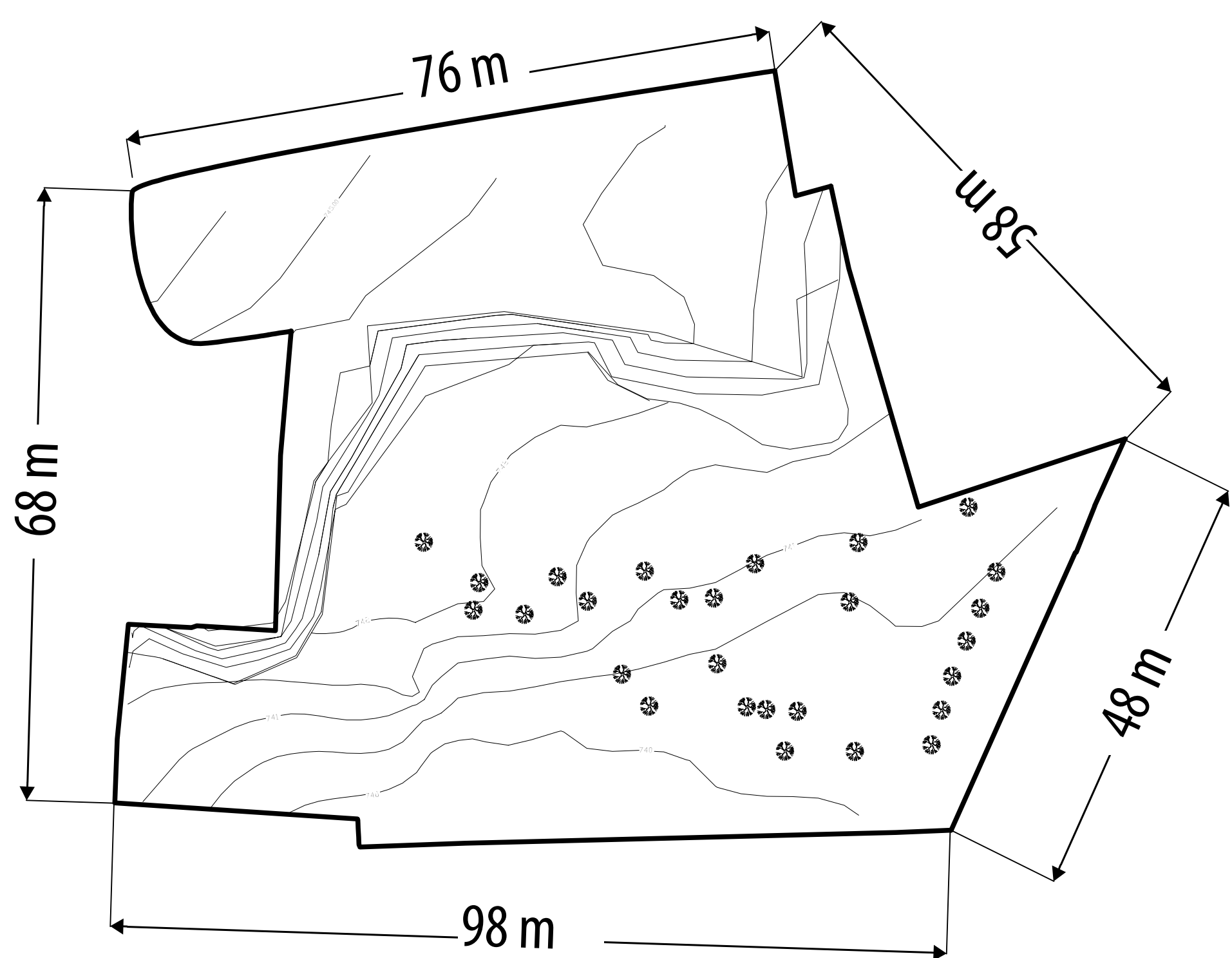


CITY PARK

Developed as a commercial and services centre in the last 10 years.

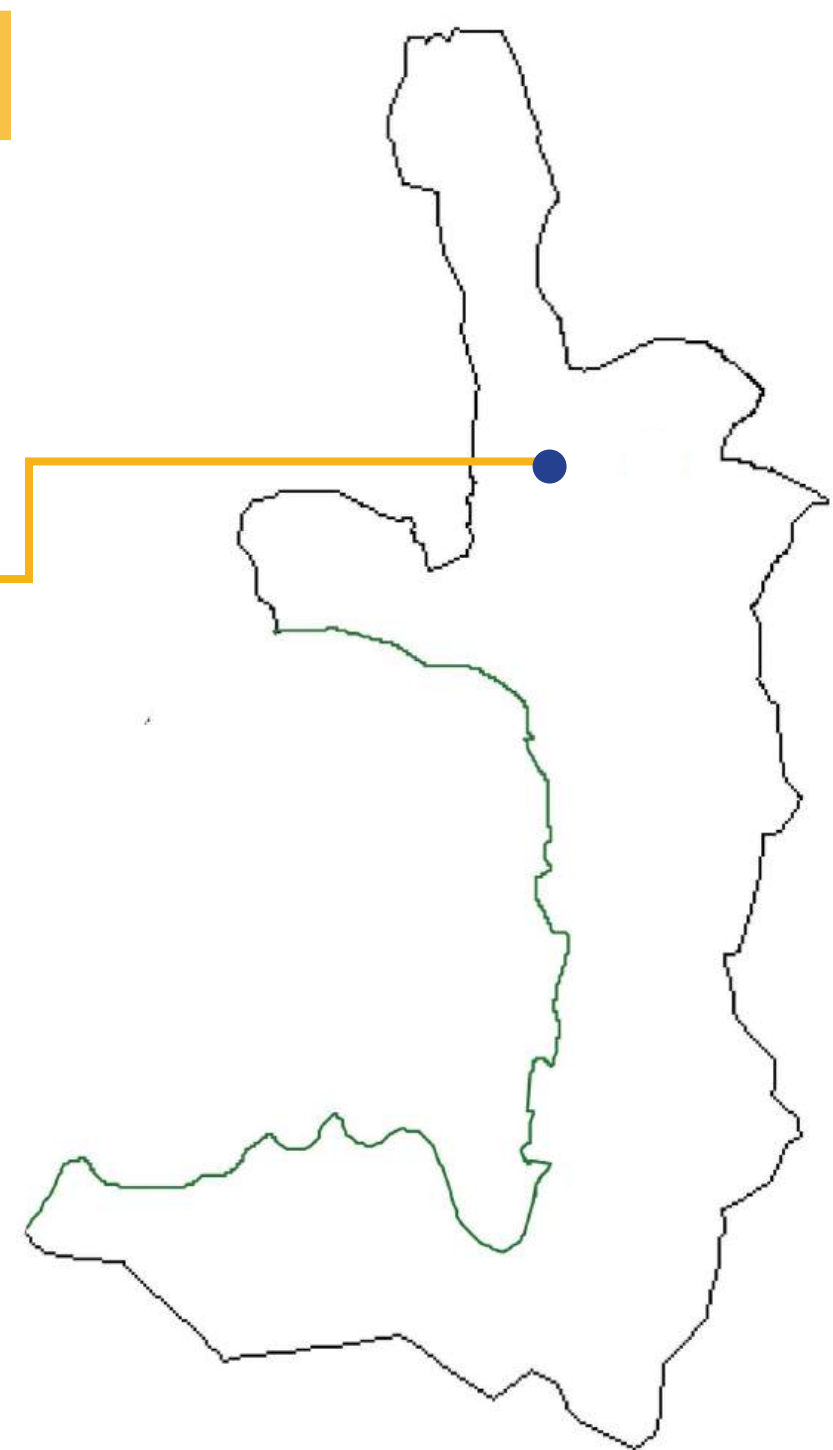

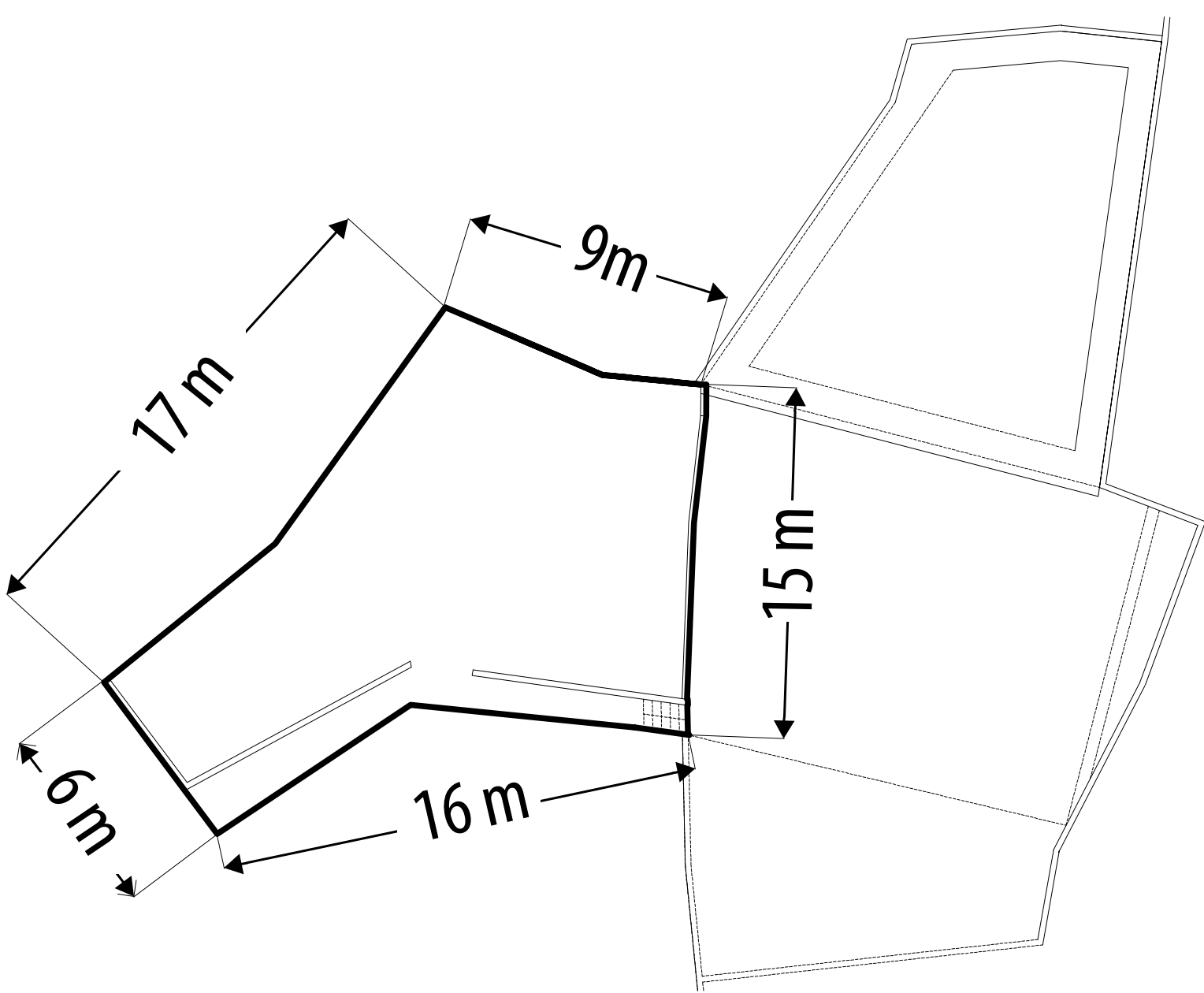


Silwan Al Bustan

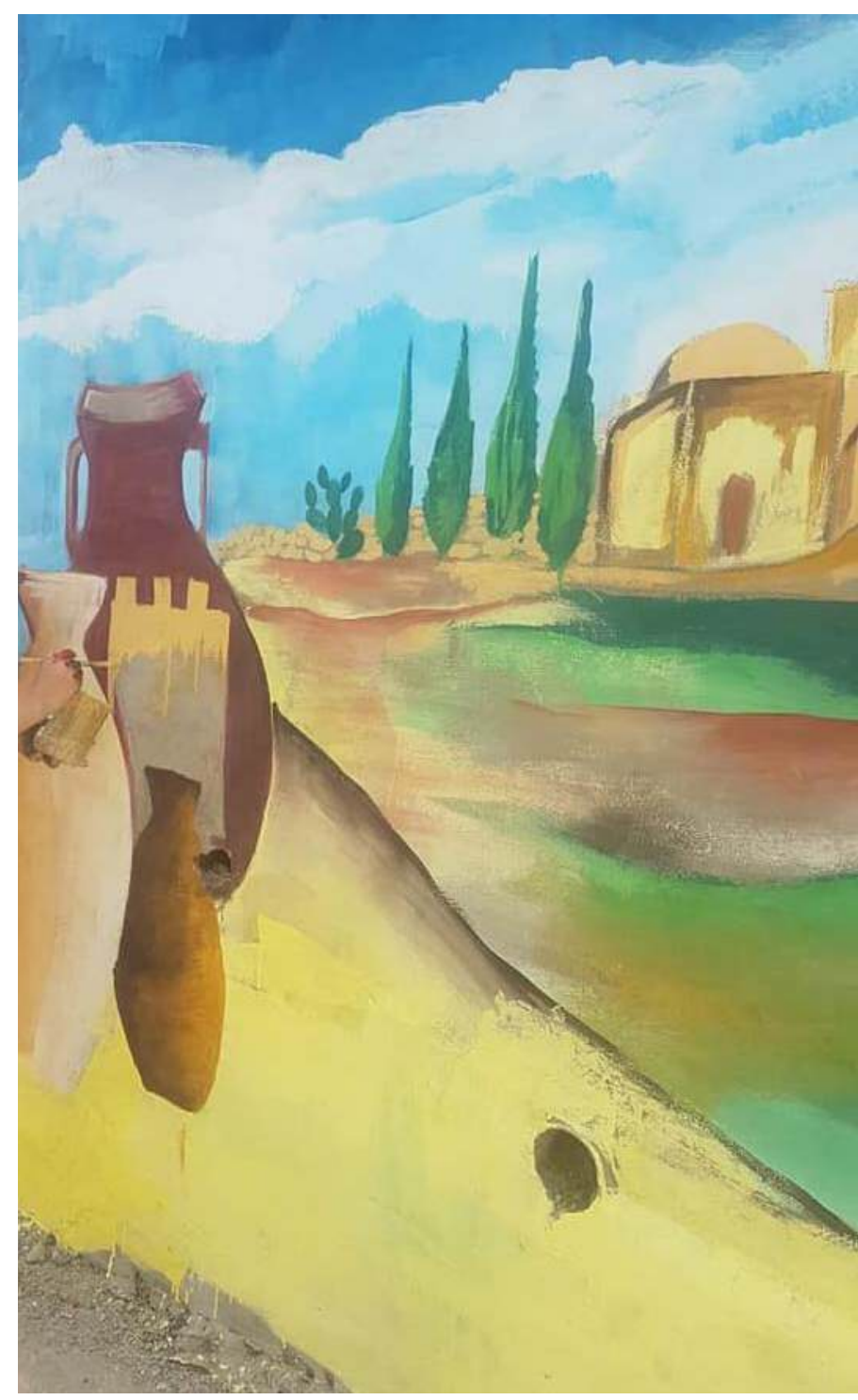

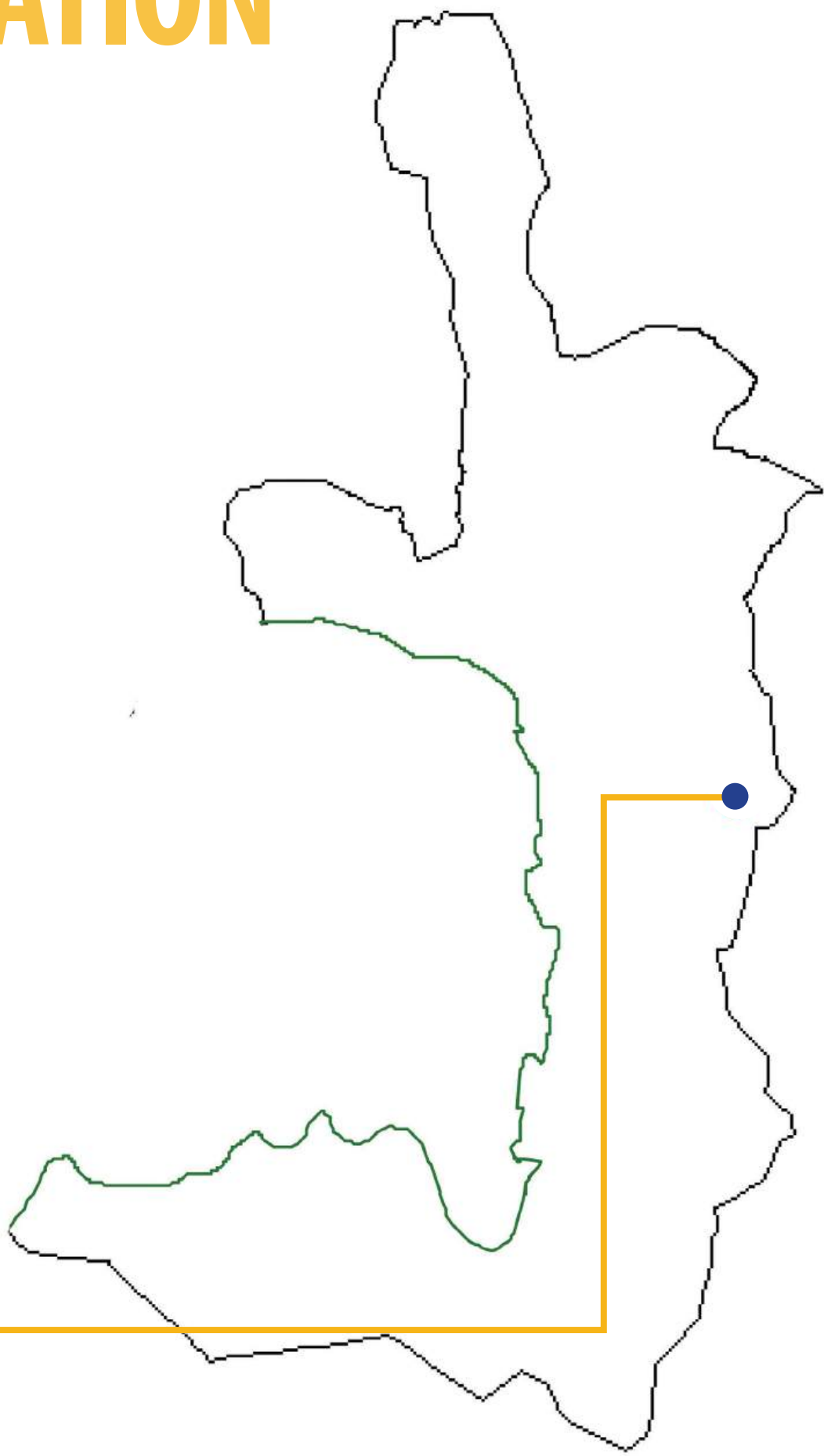

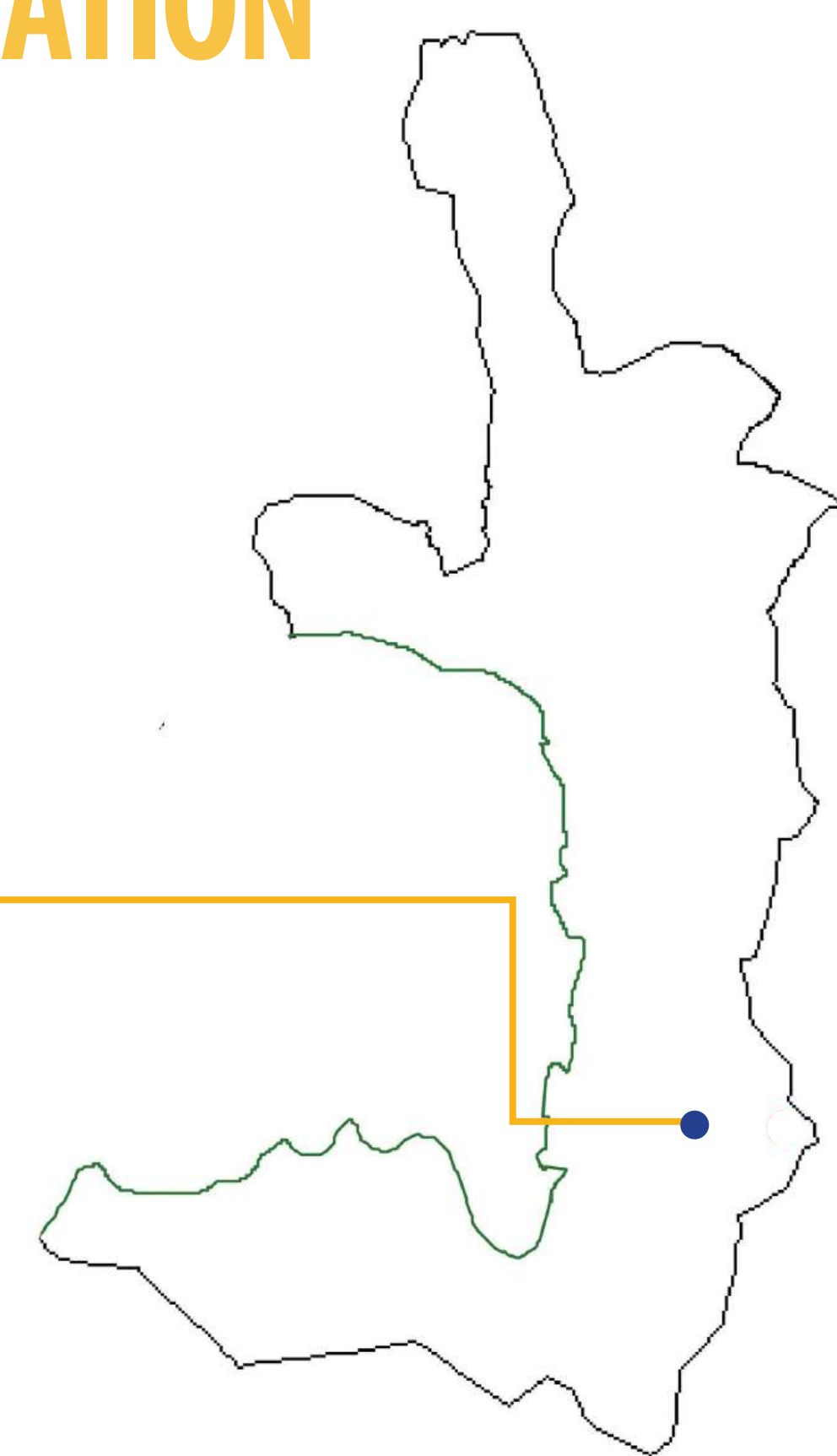
